PREPARATION SHEET – NOTIFICATION OF FLEA SERVICE

Dear Tenant

We have been hired to provide a program for flea control in your apartment/condominium building.

To make this program a success, we have several procedures that should be followed. They are listed below:

- All units should be inspected. If you are not going to be home on the day we are scheduled to be in your building, please make arrangements to have a key left with the manager, landlord or a neighbor. This assures you and your neighbors of a thorough and complete inspection/service.
- Please remove all items from the floors (does not include furniture) so that we may access as much area as possible.
- Perform a thorough vacuuming of all floors, including base of walls. Vacuum bag should be discarded in outside trash receptacle, before and after treatment.
- Please make all perimeters of rooms accessible for inspection.
- Have pet treated as recommended by veterinarian.
- Identify all smoke detectors, inform Fire Department service is to be performed
- ALL RESIDENTS AND PETS MUST VACATE HOME FOR 4-6 HOURS
